

COMPETITION GUIDELINES

VI FORTUNY GATEWAY OF YOUNG FASHION DESIGNERS. REGISTRATION FORM.

FIRST

Young designers can participate individually or collectively. Participants must meet one of these conditions:

- _Have been born in Spain
- _Have their residency in Spain
- _Be a student of a Fashion Design School within the European Union.

SECOND

Each participant will submit his or her project(s) to a maximum of two per person or group, preferably in DIN A4 format [optional montage included]. The designs must be accompanied by a **technical description** of its construction, and fabric samples. The projects must be **original**, not having been awarded in any other competition.

THIRD

Every project submitted must be composed of a **collection of six outfits** and it can be submitted for both genders.

FOURTH

Projects can be submitted between **January 11th 2016** and **February 5th 2016**, inclusive. They can be submitted in the secretariat of the **Granada Art School** from Monday to Friday from 9am to 1pm, or sent via registered mail to: Granada Art School, C / Gracia, 4, Granada - 18002, indicating VI Young Designers Fortuny Catwalk, before the end of the deadline for project submissions.

FIFTH

There are **two categories** in this competition:

_Open Access. The competition may be entered by young designers, up to 35 years old. There will be eight collections selected in this category.

_EAG Access. For students enrolled in higher education in Fashion Design at Granada Art School [EAG]. Four collections will be selected in this category. If one of these selected projects is not presented, one of the collections from the previous category will be selected. Unselected collections will be considered for evaluation in the Open Access category.

Teachers and professors in any Design or Art School are not allowed to participate in this competition.

SIXTH

All projects must be accompanied by a photocopy of **ID, address, telephone number, e-mail, title** of the collection, **brief summary** and competition access. All be presented in a sealed envelope, identified with the title of the collection as well as the category. In the case of a group or collective the personal information and documentation must be submitted for each member.

SEVENTH

A jury composed by **prestigious professionals** will select from all of the projects submitted those which present the highest **level** of artistic and technical ability. The jury will especially value **creativity** and **modernity** displayed by the different proposals.

The jury's decision will be made public on the **fortuny.es** website on **February 12, 2016**.

EIGHTH

Choosing from the collections presented on the catwalk, the jury will award a **first prize of € 3,000** and an "Accesit" **second prize**, both based on the conceptual and formal quality.

NINTH

For each selected collection there will be a **photo shoot** with professional models, stylists and photographers, in order to obtain the **maximum diffusion** of each collection in the media.

TENTH

Projects which are not selected may be collected by the author a week after the event is held. After that time these projects cannot be claimed.

ELEVENTH

For everything else not specified in these rules, or for any questions that may arise from their interpretation, the **Organizing Committee** reserves the express and exclusive right to decide in accordance with their judgement.
